### **Fr. Francisco's Weekly Reflection**

Jesus states, "Love your neighbor... and pray for those who persecute you" (Matthew 5:43-44). These are words that can be challenging to accept and to do. But, as I stated in my homily last weekend, "ask God for the grace to help us when we find that we cannot forgive someone who has hurt us." Our neighbor is all people that we encounter. It does not matter if they think the way we do, look like us, or sound like us. Jesus is correcting that for the Jews because they only viewed their fellow Jews as neighbors. We live in a hyper politicized world that is causing great division in humanity. Division is not coming from God. We all sin and fall short of the Kingdom of God, so why do we hold people's sin against them? We have to search our hearts when this happens, as it speaks more about us personally, than it does about the person who may have sinned. Speak to Jesus about this in prayer; asking Jesus, "why am I so upset or angry?" Let the Lord into our anger, shame, and frustration so that we can be set free by His love. Isn't really all we want? The Lord's love. Our Lady of Guadalupe...Ora pro nobis!

### **Reflexion Semanal del Padre Francisco**

Jesús dice, a Ama a tu prójimo... y ora por aquellos que te persiguen (Mateo 5:43-44). Estas son palabras que pueden ser difíciles de aceptar y de hacer. Pero, como dije en mi homilía del fin de semana pasado, "pídele a Dios la gracia de ayudarnos cuando descubramos que no podemos perdonar a alguien que nos ha herido". Nuestro prójimo es toda la gente que encontramos. No importa si piensan como nosotros, se ven como nosotros, o suenan como nosotros. Jesús está corrigiendo eso para los judíos porque ellos sólo veían a sus compañeros judíos como vecinos. Vivimos en un mundo hiperpoliticizado que está causando gran división en la humanidad. La división no viene de Dios. Todos pecamos y nos quedamos cortos del Reino de Dios, entonces ¿por qué mantenemos el pecado de la gente contra ellos? ¿Tenemos que escudriñar nuestros corazones cuando esto sucede, ya que habla más de nosotros personalmente, que de la persona que puede haber pecado. Habla con Jesús sobre esto en oración; pregúntale a Jesús, ¿por qué estoy tan molesto o enojado? Dejemos que el Señor entre en nuestra ira, vergüenza y frustración para que podamos ser liberados por Su amor. ¿No es realmente todo lo que queremos? El amor del Señor. ¡Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe... Ora pro nobis!
